The letter, dated October 26, 2006, from Mike Laue, town engineer, was reviewed but not acted on because the storm water management report has not been completed. Vickie Schlieve will make copies of the letter, and two previous letters from Mike and send to Mr. Oschmann to let him know we are waiting for the storm water management report before we can move forward.

Public comment - Dave Guckenberger would like planning commission board members to start using the new project review checklist developed by MSA.
