SPECIAL MEETING

The Ashippun Town Board posted this meeting of the Davy Creek Task Force and the Ashippun Town Board.

Chairman Panozzo called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. Town Board members in attendance were: Chairman Steve Panozzo, Supervisor James Meyer, Supervisor William Bremer and Clerk/Treasurer Vickie Schlieve. Special guests were Thomas Koepp from Ruckert – Mielke Engineering, James Knowles from J.D. Knowles and Associates, and Ann Marie Kirsch, Civil Engineer from Montgomery & Associates. Also in attendance were Ron Mallow, Virginia Zuercher, Ray Zuercher, Alan Schure, James Jungbluth, and Jim Schlieve.

Mr. Koepp presented his companies background in projects comparable to the Davy Creek project.

Mr. Knowles had worked with the agencies that did the original dredging about 15 years ago. He was very familiar with the area and what was going on. He suggested that the berms along the natural waterways in the area should be located. Before duplicate work is done, the original metal report from the EPA should be located. Other things needed to proceed would be: a wetland study, a floodplain study, and soil samples.

Ms Kirsch talked about the water flow and how she could help with that.

Mr. Knowles reported that his proposal would be ready by August 14th. The next meeting of the Davy Creek Task Force will be Tuesday, August 18th at 5:00 p.m. The meeting adjourned at 6:45 p.m.
